RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Detail of anesthetics given by trainees should be recorded by them in suitable paper or logbook.
- The logbook is mandatory.
- Anesthetic trainees attached to intensive care should document their procedure activities in a logbook.
- Anesthetic trainees attached to pain service should document their procedure activities in a logbook.

FILLING IN THE LOG BOOK:

- The logbook takes the form of a table, which consists of 18 columns and 12 rows on each double page. In addition, there are two lines for comments at the bottom of each page.
- At the top of each page there are suggested abbreviations for the entries to be made in the Urgency, Supervision, and Specialty and Anesthetic Technique section of the table. Further codes for procedures, definitions of grade of supervision and the ASA classification are provided in the pages at the back of the book.

ASA Classification

ASA	Definition
ASA 1	A normal healthy patient
ASA 2	A patient with mild systemic disease
ASA 3	A patient with severe systemic disease
ASA 4	A patient with severe systemic disease that is a constant threat to life
ASA 5	A moribund patient who is not expected to survive without the operation
ASA 6	A declared brain-dead patient whose organs are being removed for donor purposes

The addition of "E" denotes Emergency surgery

Supervision Category
C=Close: the supervising physician is physically present with the resident
D=Distant: the supervising physician is available to provide review of procedure with feedback provided after care is delivered
L=Local: the supervising physician is not physically present within the hospital or other site of patient care, but is immediately available by means of telephonic /electronic modalities and is available to provide close supervision
I= Immediate: the supervising physician is physically within the hospital or other site of patient care and is immediately available to provide close supervision
